'Onyx is an incredibly fragile material and needs

careful handling,' explains Michael. 'We used 20mm slabs of Bianca pure onyx for the floor and fine 10mm pieces for the wall, which are then embedded on to glass. With back-lit lighting, you then see all the wonderful nuances in the colour of the stone.' Nickel
